Mullins calls EPA ruling a Mistake: Administration cannot ignore Climategate

Tom Mullins, candidate for New Mexico's 3rd District Congressional seat called today's determination by the EPA that Green House Gases (GHG)'s "in the atmosphere threaten the public health and welfare of current and future generations" a mistake. "New Mexicans know that the science is not settled on this subject. The President and his many czars are pandering to the United Nations and this politically timed determination will be over-ruled in court." said Mullins.

Representative Luján, whom Mullins hopes to replace, voted for the job-killing cap and trade legislation earlier this year, H.R. 2454. Mullins stated, "Representative Luján, and this administration are just plain wrong on their efforts to control New Mexican's use of energy."

Mullins, an Engineer and a student of the climate change debate has attended all three of the Heartland Institute's Conferences on Climate Change and has thoroughly researched the subject for many years. "Climate models have not accurately predicted temperature changes and the technical evidence demonstrates man's activities are not the major driver of warming" according to Mullins. More than 31,000 scientists agree with Mullins's assessment.

Recent revelations regarding data mismanagement and scientific obfuscation by some scientists, termed Climategate, have reached the major media outlets. This information has shed light on the concerted effort by alarmists to suppress opposing views on man's affect on the climate.
